Mayor Rhonda Hagan presided over the special meeting of the Bloomfield City Council calling it to order at 5:33 p.m. at the City Hall Conference Room. Council members present were Laura Barnett, Sue Case, Jim Glisson, Janet Graves, and Tammy Wimpsett. City Clerk Jean Jury was also present. Council Member Denny Howard was absent. Kentucky Standard Reporter Trey Crumbie.

BUSINESS

The Mayor presented the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 annual budget spreadsheet for the Council's review. Line item by line item was reviewed with the Mayor making clarifications of necessary expenses. In regard to employee raises for the 2016-2017 fiscal year Wimpsett made a motion, duly seconded by Graves, to include a one dollar per hour wage increase for all employees that are not on a new hire wage increase schedule or an increase caused by a 2015-2016 job promotion. ***Motion carried by unanimous decision.*** Discussion ensued on the rest of the proposed budget. To validate the correct proposed 2015-2016 year-end Public Improvement Corporation (PIC) expense, Clerk Jury asked to allow a UBS Financial Service \$25,000 CD to be redeemed and transferred to the Wilson & Muir Bank and Trust Company Public Holding Corporation bank account to make the June payment to Dave Cook Construction, Inc. Wimpsett made a motion, duly seconded by Case, to allow this transfer. ***Motion carried by unanimous decision.***

ORINANCE 2016-110, ANNUAL BUDGET: Upon completion of the budget review Glisson introduced the 2016-2017 Budget Ordinance by conducting the first reading.
